PROCEDURES FOR AANC MEMBERS TO HANG PAINTINGS IN AOM

1. Sign up with the AOM Gallery Director. Pay current dues for the month, \$64.00 payable to AOM.
2. Advertising fee for the Coloradoan ad is \$50.00.
3. Bring in work to fit your space, not too crowded. Nothing can go on the floor. Each space is allocated by the hanging committee, Deb Michaelson, Chair.
4. Hanging rules dictate at least 3" between pieces.
5. Use tacks for your name plate. Name plate is 4 x 8 approximately, you can make your own on a plain sheet of white paper and fit into the frame provided.
6. Use an AOM title card for each piece. Print neatly with a fine Sharpee. Remember the gallery takes a 35% commission on your piece if it sells. Use scotch tape on the back to adhere to the wall.
7. A print bin is provided for your matted prints; you may display and sell up to 10. You may also bring in note cards to sell up to 20 for the time period. A basket can be used, it must be on a pedestal.
8. If a piece sells you may replace it; do it as soon as possible. Hope you have great sales!
